


Cricket Junior 1Breadcrumb Recommendation

1Breadcrumb makes contact record keeping safe & simple.

As has been noted, 1Breadcrumb provides automated, effortless check in, check out procedures.

For Junior players in the upcoming season, it would be recommended that the onus of the record keeping be put on the parents of participants as opposed to adding more jobs for volunteers to complete. The below process is a walkthrough for an example parent with 2 children playing in the same morning.


Step 1 - open the 1Breadcrumb application upon arrival at game number 1.




Step 2 – Select the Check In button and enter 1 accompanying person (which would represent the single child that is participating), then select "Check IN".

Step 3 - You will see that you are now checked into ground 1, theoretically we will now drive to a different reserve and upon arrival select "Check




Step 4 - Add an accompanying person, to represent the second child that has been dropped off to play cricket.





Step 5 - You will now see that on your home screen you are checked into two grounds, in the event of a contact tracing effort, all players and those who they live with will be marked as a close contact, and therefore be recommended to be tested and isolate. **IMPORTANT** - To ensure that you're location is not used to automatically check out of grounds, please ensure that post step 3, you visit the settings page, and for the reserve/ground you are at ensure that the Auto buttons are deselected for both Check-In and Check- Out.



Note: Having spoken to stakeholders involved in the Cricket Associations 1Breadcrumb believes that the above will provide clubs with adequate contact tracing abilities (the parents phone number) and the onerous position of COVID safe officer should be able to focus on other important activities pre game.

Noting as well that the COVID officer is able to check if everyone has logged in on their phone but also that they're able to add participants in, however it would be recommended to place the onus on parents as typically pre game the team managers have many items which need their attention, and Record Keeping does not need to be one of them.
